Rules & Regulations

Classes may be split/combined/cancelled at show committee discretion.

Three horse/pony minimum to hold class.

All decisions by the judge and/or committee are final.

Judge's discretion on soundness of horses and ponies.

Unsportsmanship behavior from the rider, trainer, owner or spectator will be asked to leave the showgrounds immediately with no refunds.

There will be a two minute call on all jumping classes.

Three refusals – you leave the ring – no exceptions.

All riders must wear protective headgear when mounted. All Junior (under the age of 18) riders must wear certified ASTM/SEI model helmets.

Negative Coggins and current Rabies vaccinations must be provided for each horse and/or pony.

Points will count as follows for Champion and Reserve:
1st=7, 2nd=5, 3rd=4, 4th=3, 5th=2, 6th=1

To qualify for year end awards Riders must be current SDHPA member, must attend one SDHPA Meeting and work at least 1 hour at a show a season to qualify.

Year End Awards for Equitation classes will be Rider points. Hunter classes will be Horse/pony points. Pleasure must be the same Horse/pony & Rider combination.

Entry Fees:

SDHPA members: PreEntry \$10 per class, day of show \$15.00

Non-members: PreEntry \$15 per class, day of show \$20.00

All entries must be in writing, signed by exhibitor, parent or guardian, and such entry shall constitute acceptance of these rules and regulations.

Pre-Entries accepted by fax to (845) 855-8226 up to 2 days prior to show.

Bring your own water, as it is not available on the premises.

Walk/Trot Division:

Open to riders and horse/pony of all ages who have not competed in a walk/trot/canter class. Division will be split by experience.

NOT eligible for any other classes

Division A: Riders have never shown except for "Leadline" diagonals not to count.

Trainers only allowed in the arena.

Division B: All other riders horse or pony.

3. Walk Trot Equitation Groundpoles

Short Stirrup Division:

Open to riders 12 and under who have not jumped higher than 18 inches.

NOT eligible for any other classes

4. Short Stirrup Walk Trot
5. Short Stirrup Walk Trot Canter
6. Short Stirrup X-rails

Long Stirrup Division:

Open to riders 13 to 17 who have not jumped higher than 18 inches.

NOT eligible for any other classes

7. Long Stirrup Walk Trot
8. Long Stirrup Walk Trot Canter
9. Long Stirrup X-rails

Baby Green Hunter Division:

Open to all horses and ponies in their 1st year showing, or that have not shown over fences in the past year.

10. Baby Green Hunter Walk Trot
11. Baby Green Hunter Walk Trot Canter
12. Baby Green Hunter X-rails

Modified Equitation Division:

Open to all riders who have NOT won a blue ribbon in a maiden/novice equitation class. Fences not to exceed 2'.

13. Modified Equitation X-rails
14. Modified Equitation Over Fences
15. Modified Equitation Flat

Hopeful Hunter Division:

Open to all horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year showing, or that have not shown over fences in the last year. Fences not to exceed 2', trotting not to be penalized.

16. Hopeful Hunter Under Saddle
17. Hopeful Hunter Over Fences
18. Hopeful Hunter Over Fences

Junior Equitation Division:

Open to all riders 18 and under. Fences not to exceed 2'3".

19. Junior Equitation Flat

SDHPA Medal Division:

Open to all riding students only. Riders may be asked to perform tests 1-16 at Judge's discretion. Fences 2'3" to 2'6".

22. SDHPA Medal

Schooling Hunter Division:

Open to all horses and ponies. Fences not to exceed 2'3" May be divided in Horses & Ponies if entries warrant.

23. Schooling Hunter Under Saddle
24. Schooling Hunter Over Fences
25. Schooling Hunter Over Fences

Open Hunter Division:

Open to all horses and ponies. Fences not to exceed 2'6"

26. Open Hunter Under Saddle
27. Open Hunter Over Fences
28. Open Hunter Over Fences

Pleasure Horse/Pony Division:

Open to all riders. To be judged on horse/ponies manners and way of going. Walk, trot, canter both ways of the arena. Hunter Hack may be asked to trot 2 fences not to exceed 2'.

Leadline Class:

Open to all riders who must be on a lead. To be held around noon.
